Accommodation

Accommodation consists of 12 bedrooms on the ground floor and 7 bedrooms on the first floor, including some large family sized twin rooms.

The first floor bedrooms can be accessed by a chair lift. Our bedrooms are tastefully decorated with quality



furnishings and fittings, having benefitted from a recent refurbishment.

All of our bedrooms are located in close proximity of our modern and fully equipped bathooms. There is also a wet room on the ground floor with wheelchair access. Every room has the option for television, telephone, internet and skype access.

Food
